ABOUT THE SESSION

Jocelyn Berrios, MSW, LSW introduced the concepts of adverse childhood trauma and social determinants of health. These concepts were explored through a case scenario where a child was missing multiple medical appointments and the parent was declining helpful resources designed to promote the growth and development of the child. Session participants provided suggestions on ways to effectively work with both the parent and child to ensure the most positive outcomes. Ways of addressing previous adverse childhood trauma were explored.
