Survey to Principals

- Survey was completed and sent out a second time on September 25, 2018 to principals and superintendents! Maureen reported that she to date received 8 responses.
- With this survey we are looking to get more information on which schools have what in place in regards to health and wellness teams and policies.
- The schools that have responded: Sandyston Walpack, Sussex Tech, Valley Road, Lafayette, Hamburg, Wantage Elementary, Cedar Mt. and an unknown Sparta School.

2. Rutgers University

 On October 22nd at 11:30 am, Alma, Tracy and Deb will give a brief presentation to the School of Nursing Dept. and then meet afterwards to plan strategies with other disciplines at the university. Rutgers is planning to tap into various departments to bring spot/sustainability initiatives to Sussex County Schools. Also, to develop programs to educate the educators and parents.

3. NJ Health Collaborative's Plan:

Step 1: Form Committee (invite key members/stakeholders)

a. Recommend schools to invite students to join their wellness committee or create a student team with an adult liaison so their ideas are shared.

Step 2: Review school's current wellness policy

Step 3: Asses which policies are being enforced, which are not, and where there is room for growth/improvement.

- 21 schools have submitted data Tracy will be sending the list of schools that have not submitted data to the workgroup via email.
- Discussion regarding collecting data every three years instead of yearly. Census was we are not going to see much change within a year

- Maureen Cianci will update county school nurses of our plan, at the October 8th in-service at Newton Memorial Hospital.
