## **Community Health Improvement Plan**

### **Sussex County, New Jersey**



#### **Priority Areas for Intervention**

The Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) is designed to set priorities and coordinate resources to improve community health in Sussex County. Using data from the 2021 Community Health Needs Assessments (CHNA), **chronic disease**, **mental health and substance use**, **healthy aging**, **and maternal child health** were identified as priority areas for intervention. This document outlines the priority areas for public health intervention, as well as our community health partners' activities that improve these priority areas. The North Jersey Health Collaborative will be tracking the progress of our community partners in executing the CHIP on the <u>Sussex County Progress Tracker</u> page of the <u>NJHealthMatters</u> website.

This CHIP aligns the missions of organizations across sectors, who, through their programs and services have an impact on the health and wellbeing of their stakeholders and community members. Through education, social support, access to preventive care, screenings and resources, the North Jersey Health Collaborative brings agencies and care partners together to build a strong network. We demonstrate our collective impact using our <a href="County Progress Trackers">County Progress Trackers</a> on the <a href="NJHealthMatters">NJHealthMatters</a> website.

### **Bridging the Health Equity Gap**

Local and County offices of public health have a core set of responsibilities that include assuring an adequate local public health infrastructure, promoting healthy communities and healthy behaviors, preventing the spread of communicable disease, protecting against environmental health hazards, and preparing for and responding to emergencies. In order to effectively promote healthy communities, with the goal of creating health equity, public health needs the support of community agencies and social and human services programs. Community CHIP partners provide information, education, and interventions to individuals and communities, such as education, preventive activities, healthy lifestyle activities, referrals, and social and human services. Our ongoing process includes continually adding new partners and their programs, and an evaluation process where each organization will report on Outputs and Outcomes that will be added to the Progress Tracker on the NJHealthMatters website. This plan demonstrates how partnerships between community agencies and local offices of public health may bridge the gap in health equity by addressing the social determinants of health that have an impact on health outcomes.

44 organizations are performing 270 interventions as detailed below.
