Governance Issues: (Funding, Structures, Processes, etc.)	Health insurance – usually having Medicaid, but may also have Medicare and/or private health insurance. Every type of insurance has its own procedures. If the person has only Medicaid, then enrollment is in a Medicaid managed care organization (MCO). Can people with private insurance under parents or family receive Medicaid?
Other Relevant Information:	Barriers may include: The individual with IDD may not able to provide the family medical history of cancer and other diseases. Primary care providers not successful in obtaining this information. Legal guardianship issues. Do legal guardian's provide health history? Transportation problems. Is Access A Ride or other trans svcs available to those who are not in programs that provide transportation?
