Local-Related Issues: (Local access, processes, staffing, etc.)

Governance Issues: (Funding, Structures, Processes, etc.)	<p>Health insurance – usually having Medicaid, but may also have Medicare and/or private health insurance. Every type of insurance has its own procedures. If the person has only Medicaid, then enrollment is in a Medicaid managed care organization (MCO).</p> <p>Can people with private insurance under parents or family receive Medicaid?</p>
Other Relevant Information:	<p>Barriers may include:</p> <p>The individual with IDD may not be able to provide the family medical history of cancer and other diseases. Primary care providers not successful in obtaining this information.</p> <p>Legal guardianship issues. Do legal guardian's provide health history?</p> <p>Transportation problems. Is Access A Ride or other trans svcs available to those who are not in programs that provide transportation?</p>
