Da-sha Warren: Prematurity prevention Initiative (PPI) of the

- The Prematurity Prevention Initiative (PPI) is supported by funding by the Community Health and Wellness Unit
- PPI goal is to reduce premature births and maternal mortality among black families.
- PPI aims to reduce these rates among black families in New Jersey and informs the community on chronic diseases and their impacts on babies' health.
- PPI also shares information on preventative measures available to birthing persons, including medication designed to prevent premature births.
- Offers Community and Professional programs
- PPI also attends many community events where we provide promotional information, fact sheets, and health promotion materials

- Also provide resources such as NICU kits to birthing hospitals in New Jersey
- <u>The Maternal Experience Survey</u>, survey for birthing individuals, regardless of experience (positive or negative; any age; regardless of outcome, e.g., live birth, still birth, elected termination, or miscarriage).
  - You may also sign up to receive an implementation report to see how the data has been applied.
