GOAL:

To address mostly the basic needs of individuals receiving Cancer Screenings, and be able to navigate/provide/address additional Primary care needs such as:

Dental care, Nutrition, OBGYN/ Breast screenings, Skin care, Prostate Screenings etc.

OBJECTIVE:

Increase the resource directory of doctors participating in NJCEED by at least 3 within 6 months.

Goal:

To increase awareness and educate seniors and persons with disabilities about eating healthy and the benefits of exercise and socialization to prevent Chronic illnesses in our community and at our four community centers in Warren County.

OBJECTIVE:

Encourage adults to attend our community center to have lunch, or to participate in exercise and social events to increase nutrition education and socialization to improve their overall health.

Promote healthy exercise regimens to adults and seniors by offering various programs including Tai Chi, Chair Yoga, Chair Zumba, and Meditation.

HOW:

Post menu and calendar of events on County website and County Facebook page in addition to circulating flyers. Providing outreach in the community including attending other events in the community. Collaborate with other agencies to increase community center attendance.

Provide nutrition education presentations and materials online and at the four community centers.

Distribute Senior Farmer Market Vouchers to encourage eating healthy fruits and vegetables obtained at participating local farms and markets.

Increase attendance at each community center by 5 people each quarter over the next year.

Nurse Family Partnership – requirements: a) 1st time pregnant Mom and b) under 28 weeks

Program serving Warren County:

Parents as Teachers

Normal capacity = 50 families (with Leslie and 2 parent educators)

Due to pandemic and present job market, parent educators have found other jobs. Leslie is working with 5 families and trying to manage other families through texts/emails, but not able to provide home visits.

Need: parent educators (requirement – experience working with children 0-3 years old)

Barriers: vaccination mandate and very low salary

Other need: mental health services for low income population and who are bilingual

Observation: Since pandemic, have seen an increase in births
